UPDATE FROM THE DEARBORN



PROJECT (A. Jones): I spent the afternoon at a local hotel where several Afghan families are living. Though I am sure it was odd at first, I found a group of guys and tried to strike up a conversation. It turned out that none of them spoke English, but through the magic of Google Translate, we were able to get to know each other. This evening, I missed a call from one of the guys and had to utilize Google to make sure everything was OK. He obliged and wrote me back in English! Tomorrow some of our new Afghan neighbors will come to an ESL (English as a Second Language) program that we teach at. Later in the day, another worker and I will meet up with these guys again and talk about finding work. We are hoping to have a translator this time, but if not, Google it is! Please be praying that tomorrow's time can be a blessing to these guys and those living at the hotel, despite the language barrier!
