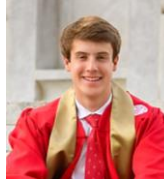

On Monday, May 23, the General Conference of the Wesleyan Church, meeting in St. Louis, Missouri, re-elected Rev. Dr. Wayne Schmidt to a four year term as General Superintendent of TWC. Schmidt was first elected

General Superintendent of The Wesleyan Church on June 6, 2016, by the North American General Conference in Buffalo, New York. Since his election in 2016, Schmidt has faithfully served the church through an extended term as General Superintendent during the uncertainty of a global pandemic. He has modeled how women and men, lay and clergy should serve together by being the first General Superintendent to include two women leaders in his cabinet, one clergy and the other lay. The vision of ethnic diversity is growing as one-third of Wesleyan churches are now multiethnic and TWC's credentialed women clergy have moved from 16% in 2016 to 21% in 2021. The Wesleyan Church has been blessed by Schmidt's passionate and unwavering commitment to prayer and sharing the hope and holiness of Christ. As Schmidt accepted his nomination, he expressed his gratitude for The Wesleyan Church and their generational ministry to his family.

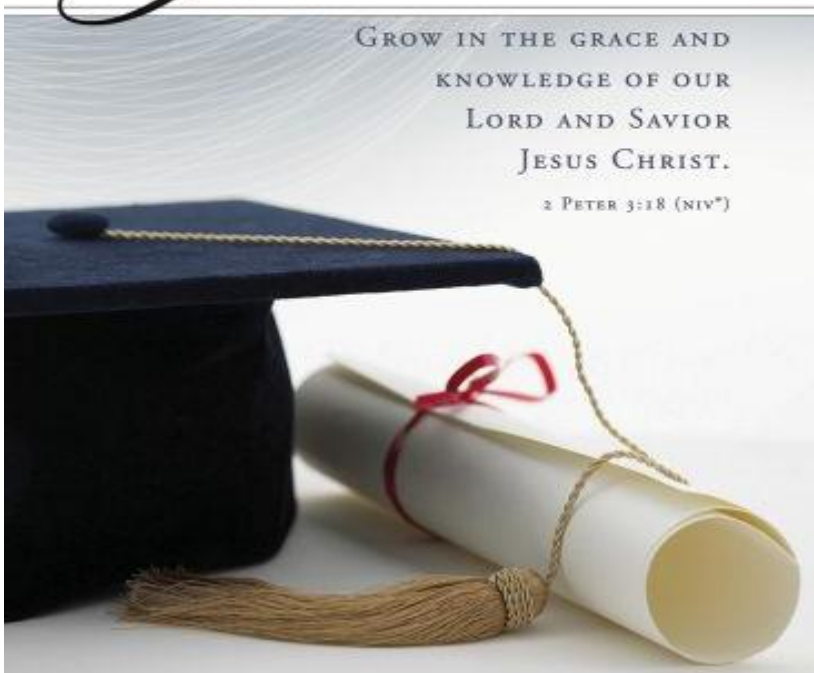
