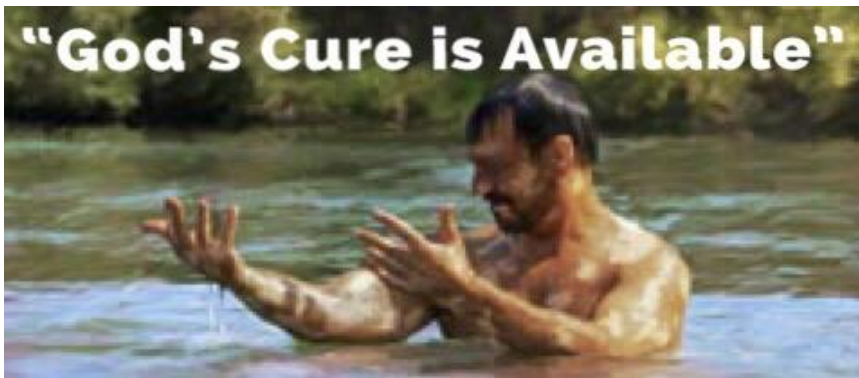

*“Now Naaman was commander of the army of the king of Aram. He was a great man. . .(and) a valiant soldier, **but he had leprosy.**” (vs. 1)*

*“If only my master would see the prophet who is in Samaria! **He would cure him of his leprosy.**” (vs. 2)*

2. God's cure was available – but Naaman

didn't _____ it

*“But Naaman **went away angry** and said, ‘I thought that he would surely come out to me and stand and call on the name of the LORD his God, wave his hand over the spot and cure me of my leprosy’. . .**So he turned and went off in a rage.**” (vs. 11-12)*

3. God's cure was available – and Naaman

finally _____ it

*“**So he went down** and dipped himself in the Jordan seven times, as the man of God had told him, and his flesh was restored and became clean like that of a young boy.” (vs. 14)*
