are excited to announce some new transitions happening! Dearborn Project is transitioning

to become an official field under Global Partners! In short, we are striking the '**PROJECT**', but instead will be a regular mission field. This change will happen September 1, 2022. We will function like the other fields Global Partners have around the world.

What will change?

- Our name! We will drop the term "Project" and just be labeled as "Dearborn."
- We will now be eligible for health insurance for our family through Global Partners. We will also have access to other resources and benefits that were not previously available to us as a project.

What will remain the same?

- Nothing changes regarding our mission to reach Muslims here with Jesus, and to equip the church to reach Muslims in their own communities.
- Adam will continue as Mission Director of our field, still involved in community programming.
- Krista will continue her roles with our team. She has recently started a new, part-time job at a low-cost healthcare clinic for expectant mothers and infants.
- We will still be funded and fully reliant on donations made to Global Partners.
