CHURCH STEEPLE UPDATE: We finally



have some good news to share about the status of the church steeple replacement. Brotherhood Mutual Insurance has reached a

settlement with Church Outlet, of High Point, N.C. (steeple provider & installer) on the cost of roof repairs, replacement, and installation. The delay has been caused by a disagreement over the cost of shingles for the storage building (also damaged during the same storm). The final settlement approved has been for \$28,624.89 (replacement, repair, & labor – minus \$1,500 deductible). We have received the check, and have scheduled the delivery and installation as soon as possible. We just wanted to keep you updated.
