Saint Valentine was a priest who conducted marriage ceremonies (and other services) in

third-century Rome. The emperor at the time was Claudius II. He briefly banned marriage for all young men – believing single soldiers in the Roman army were better. Valentine strongly disagreed with him – and continued uniting couples in marriage.

Of course, Claudius II was enraged by this act of defiance and ordered the execution of Valentine. Two centuries after Valentine's death, Pope Gelasius became the head of the Catholic Church, and decreed that February 14th should be St. Valentine's Day. It is commonly believed that the reason Valentine's Day is celebrated in February is because that was the month he was martyred.

Valentine's Day messages become increasingly popular after the year 1400 – and he became synonymous with the "Priest of Love." Valentine's Day cards first started being mass-produced in America during the 1840's.

Today, there are around *one billion* Valentine's Day cards purchased each year (along with flowers, candy, and other merchandise) - with 85% of cards being bought by women!

MISSIONARY UPDATE: Recently, I taught a



group of students from a country ruled by a dictatorship. We met through Zoom for two days of learning. These students faced possible

arrest for attending class. Together, we studied philosophy and ethics. Afterwards, students sent their evaluations, which were very positive. One person said that after living in that country for so many years, he was unaccustomed to hearing such direct talk about ideologies. I had discussed

Marxism and its effect on countries around the world in the past two centuries. We studied how important it is to understand the ideologies shaping our world today, so we can effectively minister to people in our countries.

Two students from this country want to come to the Philippines to study theology at the seminary. Their country strictly controls peoples' lives, so they need a reason to come to the Philippines. Currently, they are applying for visas to travel. Because Becky and I teach at the seminary, we can offer such students full academic scholarships. They will need to cover the other costs (e.g., housing, fees, etc.), but the academic scholarship helps.


