LBA NEWS OF INTEREST: The church board



approved the following items of interest at our February 8 meeting:

- Report was received on the purchase details of the new church bus. Final purchase price was **\$49,840**. Money on-hand: **\$42,025**. Contributions from Liberty Wesleyan Women **\$4,000**, and Liberty Young at Heart **\$4,000**. We were able to finalize the purchase with <u>no</u> financing necessary. The bus has been licensed, insured, and church graphics added. We are currently needing to add some additional drivers with CDL Passenger license.
- Church board considered the survey results of the Sunday School and Morning Worship Service Time Survey. The strong survey preference was to stay with the current schedule: S.S. – 9:00 a.m., Morning Service – 10:00 a.m. The board unanimously endorsed staying with the current service times.
- Pastor Danny reported on a meeting with Rockingham County Sheriff's Office Field Operations Commander, Capt. Grey Smith. We are offering use of the Family Life Center's S.S. Office, during the evening hours for Sheriff's Deputies to have access to restrooms, desk, WI-FI, ice, and coffee while on-duty in our area. Details are being arranged through the Church Trustees.
- Pastor Danny reported on Sr. Pastor's Health Insurance premiums for 2022.
- Church board approved contracting with Hale Fireworks & Pyrotechnics, of Lexington, N.C. to again handle our Independence Day Celebration fireworks. Details to be finalized.
- Discussed ideas for format/guest(s) for 2022 Homecoming Sunday. Contacts are being made, and details to be finalized. Tentative date: **September 18, 2022**.
- Considered offer from Jerry Price, of Price-Mill Towing, to park church bus and van inside of his fenced lot (across Price-Mill Rd.) for security purposes. We are discussing the access details with him.
