MISSIONARY UPDATE FROM TOM & GRACE ENSZ:

It is good to be back on Brazilian soil. We arrived

on Wednesday night and are just getting back into normal living. Our time in South Asia was incredible! We were so conscious of your prayers. We know that He is the One who opens doors and who shuts doors. We were pleasantly surprised that Sri Lanka was an unexpected, opened door. A couple weeks there exceeded our expectations. Our plans were to visit Bangladesh, but those doors closed. Our hearts are so full!



Ash Wednesday is normally the first day of Lent, and it occurs 46 days before Easter.

This year, it will be observed on **March 2, 2022**. The Bible does not mention Ash Wednesday or the custom of Lent, however, the practice of repentance and mourning in ashes is found in **2 Samuel 13:19; Esther 4:1; Job 2:8; Daniel 9:3; and Matthew 11:21**. It is a reminder to us of our human mortality. Biblically, sprinkling dust or ashes on our heads is an act of sincere repentance.

Lent is traditionally a time when many Christians prepare for Easter by observing a period of fasting, repentance, and moderation. In the Roman Catholic Church, members often have ashes, in the shape of the cross, put on their foreheads during the Ash Wednesday service. Protestants do not usually follow this observance, but mark the calendar date as the official beginning of the Easter season.
