Ed Welch, Christian psychologist said, "An addiction is a sin that you cannot seem to stop because it has great power over you. In this way it is a self-selected enslavement to an idol."

SIN: We get addicted to a lot of things...money, alcohol, sex, internet, drugs, video games, our cell phones, gambling, shopping, sports, Hallmark Christmas movies, and the list can go on and on...There is also some that are not so obvious... Power, manipulation, guilting, drama, attention, self-seeking, and this list can go on and on also...In the right context some of these things can be incredibly good and bring about pleasure, but when we become addicted to them, they become an idol. We become a slave and it becomes sinful.

SELF-SELECTED: Society would tell us, if you have an addiction it's a disease. Alcohol addiction...disease, drug addiction...disease. But if you have a disease that makes you a victim. We aren't victims of our addictions, we have freely chosen them ourselves, at least we choose them at the beginning.
