CHURCH STEEPLE UPDATE: We finally



have some good news to share about the status of the church steeple replacement. **Brotherhood Mutual** Insurance has reached a

settlement with Church Outlet, of High Point, N.C. (steeple provider & installer) on the cost of roof repairs, replacement, and installation. The delay has been caused by a disagreement over the cost of shingles for the storage building (also damaged during the same storm). The final settlement approved has been for \$28,624.89 (replacement, repair, & labor – minus \$1,500 deductible). We are now awaiting receipt of the check, and will schedule the delivery and installation as soon as possible. We just wanted to keep you updated.



During the past two years, we have been amazed - and *grateful* – for the incredible faithfulness of our people's tithing and giving during the


