FALL BAZAAR: The Liberty Wesleyan Women are excited to announce

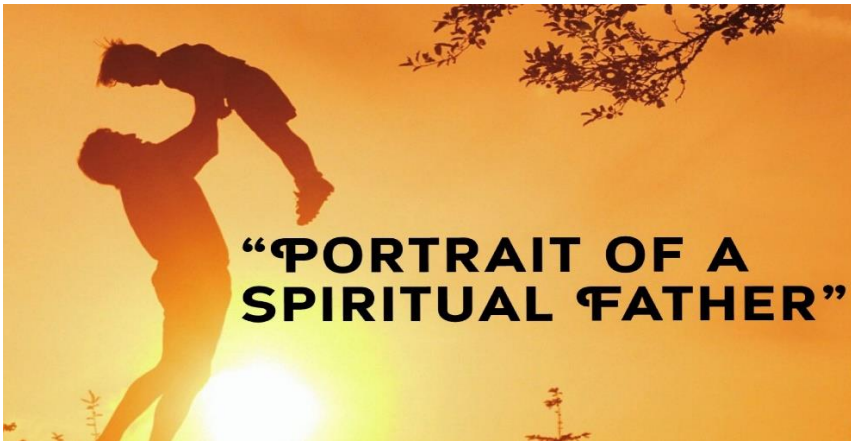
