morning service. The

Collins are the newest addition to our Liberty Missions Support. They are preparing to leave the U.S. for their first term of service in Cambodia as soon as their remaining support is secured. Cambodia is a relatively small country in South-East Asia, just below Vietnam, with about 16 million people in it. Most of the population believes in Buddhism with it being the national religion. Sadly, only about 1% of the people living there proclaim Christianity.

After a short trip to Cambodia, Andrew and Lexi fell in love with the beautiful country. They felt like they had found their new home. After time of discerning and praying, they followed the Lord's leading and surrendered to his will. A song that they live by says, "I will build my life upon Your love, it is a firm foundation."

Their desire is to build their lives upon God and express his love with those around them. Andrew and Lexi long to share the good news with the people in Cambodia and to see "no dark places" remaining there.

While there, Andrew and Lexi hope to learn the native language of Khmer. This will assist them with their Initiatives in Cambodia:

- O.C. Program: The Oral Curriculum Program is an educational program being used to equip leaders with Theology and Bible lessons so that they can be ordained in The Wesleyan Church.
- C.H.E. Program: The Community Health Evangelism Program equips village leaders with basic health care practices to teach the other villagers.
- Teaching English_to children and teens
