
YOUNG at HEART NARROWAY TRIP: On

MISSIONARY UPDATE FROM ANGIE



HEMRIC: While I am currently not residing in Guyana, I continue to work for Guyana and prepare for a return when the time is set in 2023. The learning center offers internet for our

students to access for completion of school assignments. The connection is there through text communication, video calls, and voice messages. We remain connected, and the community knows where to go if I need to be reached or if they want to know how I am.

In June 2023, I was scheduled to return home for 3-6 months of partnership development. However, Global Partners has agreed that a better plan is to shift that time forward to begin in late January. The fantastic news is with your agreement to continue support into the next four-year term, I will be financially cleared to return. I am 87% funded by pledges, while overall, giving sits at 99%. This means giving happens beyond pledges through individuals and churches, making up the 13% differential. Prayer partnerships are as vital as financial ones, providing a spiritual covering that sustains, protects, uproots darkness, and empowers growth.

I am overjoyed that God has knitted us together for the work in this little corner of a little country called Guyana. So, from all those I call family, May God's strength be your strength and His peace known in your heart and home. In Christ, with Thanksgiving, Angie
