MISSIONARY UPDATE: (NOTE: Due to

among the Arab/Muslim community. Below are a *few highlights of their recent work.)*

The past few months, our Dearborn (Michigan) team has hit the ground running! We are both exhausted and enthused at the same time. After many, many months of cancelled plans it was a thrilling feeling to see so many things come to fruition.

AFGHAN REFUGEES: Like many places all over the US, Afghan refugees are being resettled in and around Dearborn. The vast majority lived in a local hotel for upwards of 6 months, with little access to transportation, shopping, or even cooking meals. We've had lots of opportunities to connect with these dear people. It began with TESOL classes (Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages) at a local hotel but has turned into other tangible chances to serve this community and build trusting relationships. Now that many are being settled into apartments or homes we are hoping to continue investing in our newest neighbors.

SHORT TERM TEAMS: Since January, we have had five short-term teams visit, including two work teams from Hillside Wesleyan in Port Huron, MI who have helped get Habibi Haus into working order. Ages have ranged from 20 to 80 on these past teams, and their experiences have been both encouraging to us and a blessing to the community.
