The **Sermon on the Mount** occupies a place of singular importance in the Scriptures. Beginning in the Gospel of Matthew, chapter 5, and continuing through chapter 7, it is the longest uninterrupted sermon/teaching of Jesus recorded in the Bible. It is the most comprehensive declaration of Christ's purpose, authority, and intent for His followers preserved in writing. It endures to this present day as the greatest message ever delivered to build our lives upon.

Since first memorizing the entire **Sermon on the Mount** in 1988, I have had the opportunity to present it in several churches and other gatherings. My greatest thrill has been getting to deliver it on the actual site where Jesus preached it in Galilee when I traveled to Israel in 2008 and 2010. I try to present it on alternating years in the church.

I chose to memorize it as translated in the *King James Version* — simply because I prefer the majestic sound of the "King's English." I do not wear a costume or wig to try to resemble the person of Christ. My hope is that more attention will be given to the *message* than to the *messenger*.

If you do not know Christ as your personal Savior today, it is my deepest wish that you will accept His invitation to, "Come unto me."
