Liberty Wesleyan Church, Last year, we told you about one of our students studying in a war zone. In April 2021, James

apologized for missing classes when the military cut the Internet connection to his city. At the time, soldiers were burning houses and shooting people in the street. Eventually, James dropped out of sight. He stopped turning in assignments and attending online classes. The faculty withdrew him from his courses, and we prayed and waited.

So, it came as a surprise when James showed up on campus this summer in the Philippines. James escaped to India from Myanmar, before traveling on to Nepal. Then, he flew through Bangkok to the Philippines to reach the seminary. Today, he lives safely on campus pursuing his theological education. Other students from Myanmar continue to study at the seminary also. These precious people have become "educational refugees." These students prepare themselves for future ministry in a country torn by dictatorship. Thanks for your church's partnership with the Father to train these young brothers and sisters.
